Relationship between Health Share of Oregon & CareOregon (Portland metro)

Health Share of Oregon is a coordinated care organization (CCO) that provides health care services to Oregon Health Plan members in the tri-county Portland metro area. It offers a range of physical, dental, and mental health care services. CareOregon is a founding partner of Health Share of Oregon. It collaborates with Health Share to serve the tri-county Portland metro area, ensuring members have access to comprehensive health care services.

Additional benefits administered through CareOregon

CareOregon Behavioral Health provides comprehensive mental health and substance use treatment services to members enrolled in the Oregon Health Plan (OHP). These services include counseling, psychotherapy, substance use treatment, and detox programs. CareOregon ensures that members have access to necessary mental health care at no cost, supporting their overall well-being and recovery.

CareOregon Dental is a Medicaid dental plan that offers dental care to OHP members in Multnomah, Clackamas, Washington, and Tillamook counties. The plan covers a wide range of dental services, including exams, cleanings, fillings, extractions, and limited coverage for crowns, root canals, and dentures. CareOregon Dental partners with local providers to ensure members receive convenient and accessible dental care.

CareOregon family



CareOregon Advantage is a health care plan that combines Medicaid and Medicare benefits and offers extra benefits for eligible members. It provides comprehensive, coordinated care, including physical, dental, mental health care, and prescription drug coverage. CareOregon Advantage is part of the CareOregon family, offering a special needs plan (SNP) for members dually eligible for Medicare and Medicaid. It aims to provide high-quality care with additional benefits and access to a wide network of providers.



Columbia Pacific CCO serves more than 36,000 Oregon Health Plan members in Clatsop, Columbia and Tillamook counties. It provides coordinated medical, dental and mental health care, along with additional services like free transportation to medical appointments and pharmacies. Columbia Pacific CCO was founded in 2012 through a partnership between CareOregon and Greater Oregon Behavioral Health Inc. (GOBHI). The health plan's mission is to inspire local connections that foster member health and community resilience.



Jackson Care Connect is a nonprofit, locally governed coordinated care organization (CCO) serving over 60,000 residents of Jackson County. It provides free physical, dental, mental health care and prescription drug coverage through the Oregon Health Plan (OHP). Jackson Care Connect has been part of the CareOregon family since 2012. It is guided by a local board of directors, community advisory council and deep community ties. Jackson Care Connect proudly partners with organizations that promote a healthy region and address barriers to health equity.



Housecall Providers is a nonprofit healthcare organization that delivers in-home medical care to homebound or seriously ill patients. It offers specialized care through its Advanced Illness Care program, which helps relieve symptoms and stress of serious illnesses. Housecall Providers became an official member of the CareOregon family in 2017. It continues to operate as a separate nonprofit, retaining its name, providers, patients, services, and location.
